## Comfort Quilt Program Guidelines

	RECOMMENDED	CONSIDERATIONS
Fabric	100% Cotton - Quilting Weight	Please avoid rayon, synthetic, metallic, stiff, and scratchy fabrics Inappropriate subject matter
Pattern	Quilter's Choice Free simple quilt patterns are available on the web. For inspiration, <u>https://www.allpeoplequilt.com/quilt-</u> <u>patterns/35-free-quilt-patterns-beginners</u>	
Size	Minimum 44"x44", approximate Maximum 55"x75", approximate Quilt back 4 to 5 inches larger on all sides	Sizing can be very flexible. Please reach out with any questions about quilt size
Binding	Quilter's Choice	If you have questions about binding or need assistance with this step, please let us know!
Quilting	Machine quilting with low-loft batting. Please do not use high loft batting.	Please do not tie finish If you need assistance with machine quilting, we have access to long-arm quilters who can help!
Label	A label will be added to the quilt that reads: This quilt is a gift from Friends of Hopewell House	If you would also like to add a label of your own, please feel free to do so.
Washing	Please wash your quilt after it is quilted and bound.	Avoid scented laundry products Do not send a quilt covered in pet hair or one exposed to smoke
Delivery	Wrap quilt in a protective covering with a Completed Project Form. Email quilts@fhhpdx.org to arrange pick-up or delivery.
